



COVID-19 SAFETY GUIDELINES

Lakeshore Students will follow all safety guidelines for Lakeshore Community Church to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. In addition, Lakeshore Students will adhere to the following guidelines that are specific for students and adults in Lakeshore Students.

- Any student who is not feeling well, exhibiting symptoms of COVID-19, or has a fever is asked to refrain from coming to church that day.
- Students and Adult Leaders will be expected to wear masks upon enter the church building and while moving about the building and the Student Space.
- If a student forgets to bring a mask Lakeshore Students will have extra masks on hand.
- Students and Adult Leaders will be expected to maintain 6' of distance between each other at all times. The leadership of Lakeshore Students will do their best to provide socially distant games and activities as a part of our services and gatherings for students.
- Once students are seated in the Large Gathering Space, they can remove their mask if they choose to, so long as they are maintaining 6' of distance between them and others.
- Seating will be arranged in rows with 6' of space in front and behind each row.
- There will be hand sanitizing stations located in the Student Space and around the church building.
- All Adult Leaders will go through a health screening and temperature check prior to serving to determine if they are cleared to serve that day.
